- Order Mayor, Dallas Lowdermilk called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
- 42/21 Fischl: That the minutes of the regular meeting of council held on March 10, 2021 be approved as read. Carried.
- Corres. a) Government of Saskatchewan - Confirmed School Mill Rates  
b) Municipal Revenue Sharing  
c) RCMP – Stats and Policing Priorities
- 43/21 Corresp. Owen: That the correspondence presented be filed. Carried.
- 44/21 Financial Englesman: That the financial Statement and Bank Reconciliation for the month ended March, 2021 be approved as presented. Carried.
- 45/21 Accounts Ouellette: That we ratify the accounts that were paid before this meeting by cheques numbered #12009 through #12025 listed on Appendix “A” totalling \$ 32,302.11 and that the submitted accounts listed in Appendix “A” totalling \$ 3,663.20 be approved for payment with cheques numbered #12026 through #12026. - Englesman, Fischl and Lowdermilk returned to the boardroom at 9:27 pm.
- 46/21 In-Floor Heating Ouellette: That the Village continue with Rapid Plumbing doing the In-Floor Heating project. Carried.
- 47/21 Culvert Lowdermilk: That the Village replace the culvert on the south east side of the Petro Canada entrance with the limit of \$5,000.00. Carried.
- 48/21 Co-op Alley Owen: That the Village send a letter in regards to the complaint of damage done to the Alley behind the Co-op to the Canada Post stating that the Village will repair the alley in this case. Carried.
- 49/21 Building Inspector Englesman: That the village appoint MuniCode Services Ltd. as the Village of Kenaston’s building official company. Carried.
- 50/21 Tree Trim Ouellette: That the Village trim a tree branch from a village tree that may break off and damage a property located at Lot 3 & 4, Block 11, Plan G201. Carried.
- 51/21 Bylaw Ouellette: That Bylaw 2/21 being a bylaw to set a minimum tax and a variable mill rate factor be introduced and read a first time. Carried.
- 52/21 Owen: That bylaw 2/21 be now read a second time. Carried.
- 53/21 Fischl: That bylaw 2/21 be given three readings at this meeting. Carried.
- 54/21 Lowdermilk: That bylaw 2/21 be now read a third time and adopted. Carried.
