## BYLAW No. 4/95

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF KENASTON TO CLASSIFY REGULATE AND LICENCE ANY BUSINESS, TRADE OR CALLING NOT ASSESSABLE FOR THE PURPOSES OF BUSINESS TAXATION IN RESPECT TO THEIR BUSINESS, TRADE OR CALLING

The Council of the Village of Kenaston in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows.

- In this Bylaw the expression "transient trader" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Urban Municipality act, 1984.
- No person shall carry on any business, trade or calling set out in section 9 of this bylaw within the village unless he has in his possession a valid and subsisting licence for the purposes issued in accordance with the provisions of this bylaw.
- The Clerk/Administrator of the Village is hereby authorized to issue a licence to any person carrying on a business, trade or calling in the Village
- a) Who is not assessable by the Village for the purpose of business taxation in respect to that business, trade or calling; and
- b) Who makes application for such licence stating specifically the nature of his business in the Village; and
- c) Who tenders with his application the proper licence fee as provided for in Section 9.
- Every licence issued under the authority of this Bylaw unless suspended or revoked shall expire on the 31st day of December of the year of issue.
- Where a licence is issued after the 30th day of June in any year the fee payable under section 9 shall be reduced by 30  $\!\!\!^{\$}\!\!\!^{\$}$  .
- Every licence issued shall specifically state the kinds of services goods or merchandise which the licensee is authorized to offer for sale or take orders for as the case may be and whether in the case of goods or merchandise, he may offer the same for sale by retail or by public auction or both. Such licence shall also state the restriction as set forth in section 7 hereof.
- No person to whom a licence has been granted under this bylaw shall offer for sale services, goods or merchandise or solicit orders for future delivery of goods or merchandise within the Village:
- a) other than a kind or kinds described in the licence; or
- b) by any method except stated in the licence; or
- c) at any time or during any period when shops within the Village offering for sale or taking orders for similar services, goods or merchandise are required by Village bylaw to be and remain closed.
- Every person licensed under this Bylaw shall, at all reasonable times, upon request of the Clerk/Administrator, the bylaw enfocement officer or licence inspector, or any peace officer, produce such licence for inspection pruposes.

- 9. Subject to Section 5 the fee payable for a licence under this Bylaw shall be as follows:
  - a) for a transient trader \$ 200.00
  - b) for any person or company carrying on any business within the Village that is not specifically provided for in this bylaw
- 10. A licence under this Bylaw is not required if the person or company is hired to work for the Village unless he does other work within the Village for individuals.
- Any person who contravenes the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty 11. of an offence and upon conviction shall be liable to the penalty provided for by the General Penalty Bylaw of the Village.
  - Bylaw No. 9/90 is hereby repealed.
